The Interior and Design Biennale in Kortrijk, Belgium, is a popular event, whose 21<sup>st</sup> edition traditionally showcased innovative ideas, functional products and limited editions. Fabio Novembre, Michael Sheridan, Erwan Bouroullec are to name only a few of those having given lectures, workshops, discussions and presentations on innovative design, new applications and trends. This year member of honour was young Spanish designer Jaime Hyon, who will join the many renowned designers before him, such as Constantin Grcic, James Urvine, Philippe Starck, Alessandro Mendini, Jan Nouvel, Jasper Morrison. His multiplicity, known from original children's toys, shoes, furniture, interior design and artistic installations, combined with non-traditional approach to designing and unique style, make him the perfect choice as a person who astonishes, reflects modern creative spirit and has already stepped into the future. A highlight at the exposition was the prototype competition, formerly known as *Design for Europe*. 286 projects from 33 countries centred on three thematic subjects: Working, Playnig and Living. The jury was looking for the new and unconventional, where choice of materials, use and aesthetics go hand in hand. First prize went to Ishéle Levy from Amsterdam for the project *Unite 1406 + Unite 2604*. Among other winners were James Van Vossel, Laurina Ieva, Rafael Charles, Vincent Colot. ■
